SUBMISSIONS

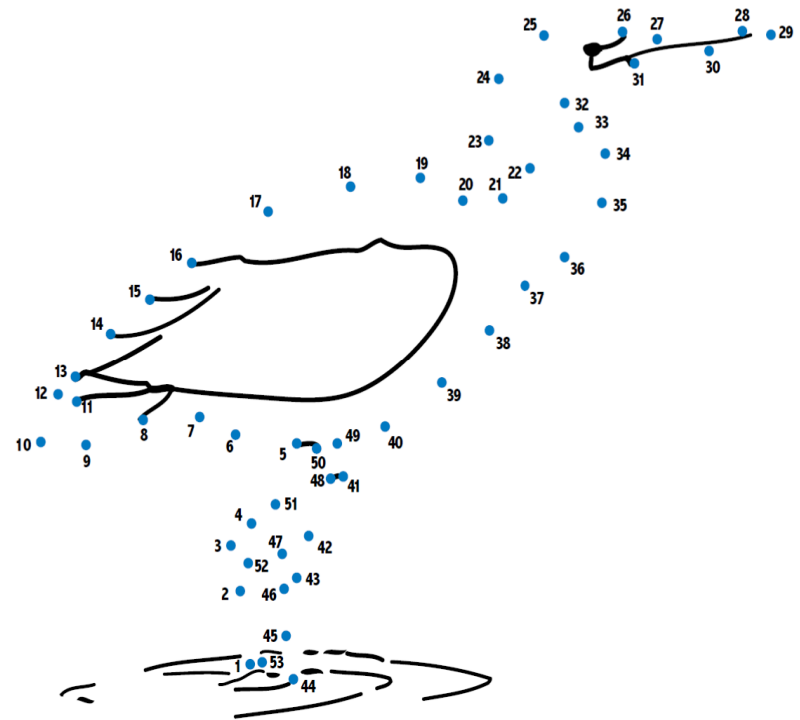
