2023 “National Estuaries Week Photo Contest” Rules

This annual photo contest is held to celebrate National Estuaries Week and to focus on the wonder and the beauty of the Hampton-Seabrook Estuary.

ELIGIBILITY: The contest is open to anyone over the age of 8 as of September 1, 2023.

QUALIFYING PHOTOS: Photos taken in the Hampton-Seabrook Estuary, which includes the undeveloped areas west of Rt. 1A in Seabrook and Hampton; north of Rt. 1 in Seabrook; east of Drakeside Road in Hampton; and south of High Street in Hampton.

CATEGORIES: Landscapes; Sunrise/Sunset; Wildlife; Weather. You may submit up to 5 photos featuring 1 or multiple categories.

WHEN: All entries must be received via email by 5:00 p.m. US EDT on September 23, 2022. Send your photos to: jdiener@shea4nh.org

HOW: Up to 5 photographs may be submitted per person. If the judges determine that a photographer has altered their photo, we reserve the right to disqualify it. If your photo includes recognizable people, especially children, you need to submit a model release form signed by each person in your photo(s) with your entry. Each entry must include your name, mailing address, email address, age, and category.

FILE REQUIREMENTS: Digital images or scans of prints may be uploaded. Original files of camera-made digital photos should not exceed five megabytes (5 MB). SHEA cannot be responsible for lost, damaged, late, misdirected entries or technical malfunctions.

JUDGING: Entries will be judged on composition, quality, originality, and relevance. Decisions made by the judges are final.

PRIZE AWARDS: Prizes will be awarded within sixty (60) days after winner verification. SHEA reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value for any reason. All taxes and any other incidental expenses related to the Prizes are the sole responsibility of each winner. For questions regarding the 2023 Photo Contest, please email info@shea4nh.org.
